Whitford moves to new, considerably expanded corporate headquarters

20 November 2006, Elverson, PA. Whitford Worldwide has just moved from its corporate home of 20 years in Frazer, PA to a far larger facility located in Elverson, PA, about 20 miles northwest of Frazer.

The new factory, an unusually modern and sophisticated building, includes 210,000 square feet of usable space (Whitford's previous factory was 60,000 square feet). Whitford has made some modifications to accommodate its equipment, but the basic structure, electrical power, air conditioning, etc. were in excellent condition.

What did require new (and major) construction was the office building. The original, little more than an old shack, had to be demolished. In its place now stands a state-of-the-art building (see photo above) that has 23,000 square feet of space, more than twice that of the previous facility.

The new Elverson facility offers many advantages, among them more than enough space to consolidate Whitford's sister company, Polymeric Systems, Inc. (PSI), into the site. PSI now has 15,000 square feet of office/laboratory and 65,000 of factory and warehouse space. The new home will dramatically expand the space available for them. PSI, presently located in Phoenixville, PA, will be moving sometime after the first of the new year.

Said David P. Willis, Jr., president of Whitford, "The new facility is first-class — and provides room for expansion for many years to come." Added Debra Parkes, general manager of PSI, "This finally lets us integrate fully into Whitford, something we've wanted to do ever since we joined the family in 2004."
